INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place no more than 4 phones in a padded jiffy bag.
 2. Read & sign "**Sender's Packaging and No Dangerous Goods Declaration**" on the Reply Paid Label.
 3. Complete Sender's Details Label, writing clearly in Block Letters.
 4. Cut out and fix the Reply Paid Label and the Sender's Details Label onto a sturdy bag with glue or sticky tape.
 5. Seal the bag and post it at any Street Post Box or at any Australia Post Outlet.
